wo Ph. D and 79 master's graduates marched on stage during the 69th VSU Commencement Exercises held in the Upper Oval of VSU on August 12, 2022. For the first time in two years, the postgraduate students of Class 2022 were permitted to celebrate inperson graduation. The graduates excitedly wore their toga and marched to the venue escorted by their parents or guardians. The graduation rites concluded with a spectacular fireworks display. The graduation ceremony of Class 2022 was aired live on the official Facebook page and YouTube channel of VSU.



A separate in-person graduation ceremony was also conducted on August 11 for graduates of Class 2020 and 2021. Graduates of these two batches already had a virtual graduation during the pandemic but requested for in-person graduation, which the university gladly granted.

During the second half of the school year 2022-2023 we focused on various activities for internationalization, working to expand our linkages globally. These activities were crucial for establishing new graduate degree programs, strengthening our existing ones and linkages with other universities and industry partners abroad.

On July 4-8, I was given the oportunity to attend and present a paper during the 23rd Biennial Conference and General Asspembly and 50th AAACU Founding Anniversary with the theme "International Forum on Agricultural Innovation, Sustainability, Entrepreneurship and Networking in Maejo, University, Chiang Mai in Thailand. My presentation of our study entitled "Enhancing the growth, yield, and tuber quality of two purple sweetpotato through macro and micronutrient biofortification" was awarded with the best presentation award. On top of that, five out of six awards were bagged by VSU faculty and alumni.

The five-day conference provided me the opportunity to create linkages with other researchers, universities and industry partners in Thailand and other universities in the ASEAN region. The conference was also a good venue for sharing current knowledge and advances in agricultural innovation and sustainability.

Another internationalization activity that I s p e a r h e a d e d t o g e t h e r w i t h m y internationalization team was our visit to four collaborating universities in Belgium on October 2-16, 2022. We were invited by KU Leuven (Katholieke Universiteit Leuven), Vrije Universiteit Brussel (VUB), Hasselt University, and Ghent University. One of the highlights of our internationalization activity was the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between VSU and Hasselt University. There, I was able to discuss about our proposed joint offering of MS degree programs in Sustainable Development in KU Leuven and Master of Science in Statistics and Biostatics with the Hasselt University.

In the homefront, we were fortunate to be visited by our project collaborators from Czech Republic. Our graduate students have also witnessed the presentation of results of a joint research project between Czech University of Life Sciences Prague and VSU on biologically active natural products. The Consul of Czech Republic was also present for the launching of 1 million worth of laboratory equipment donated to the Advanced Research Innovation Center (ARIC), VSU

I also want to share with you our learning visit to the Universiti of Putra Malaysia (UPM), University of Malaya (UM) and Singapore Management University (SMU). We were able to learn a lot as regards internationalization programs of both universities and their various MS and Ph.D degree programs. The visit was very helpful to help us formulate a good proposal that we can share with other researchers, university and industry partners.

The VSU Graduate School is hopeful that we will be able to strengthen our linkages and collaborations with other universities abroad. With the new knowledge and experience learned during these learning visits, meetings and discussions, I am positive that we can establish more joint research collaborations, MOU establishments and sharing of graduate programs with other universities abroad.

There's more that needs to be done for the Graduate School. We sill continuously share with you our ventures and successes for the advancement of our graduate education programs as we look forward to our centennial celebration in 2024. Till then!

he Graduate School Dean, Dr. Anabella B. Tulin, set another record for being the first Viscan who received the University of the Philippines Alumni Association (UPAA) Distinguished Alumni Award for her service in Poverty Alleviation and Human Development. The honorable Dean received the award on November 9, 2022 in a social event hosted by Prof. Danilo Lardizabal Concepcion, the President of the University of the Philippines. The UPAA Distinguished Alumni Award is granted to alumni who showed remarkable achievements and contributions in their chosen fields.

The award recognizes Dr. Tulin's leadership and achievements in the field of soil science. She made exemplary and remarkable contributions as a soil scientist in research and extension projects. Her research in micronutrient and biochemical studies on tuber and root crops made several pioneering contributions especially in the marginal communities in the country. Dr. Tulin's research and extension projects paved way for the




university to secure more research and development funding from both national and international agencies.

Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between Hasselt University and VSU. The team was introduced to the directors, head of offices. deans of various faculties, program in-charge of several projects offering scholarships, professors, Belgian scientists, MS and PhD Filipino students, and VSU alumni working in Belgium. VSU and KU Leuven discussed about the joint offering of Master of Science in Sustainable Development; and Master of Science in Statistics and Biostatics with Hasselt University. KU Leuven shared strategies on how to get to the top of the world ranking, such as producing high quality research and being able to attract sufficient research funding. They also shared with VSU the various scholarships that VSU faculty and students can apply in Belgium, as well as the qualifications of students accepted to the MS Sustainable Development Program and VLIR-OUS Scholarship. Meanwhile, VSU showed videos of its internationalizations program and projects and stressed the need for possible collaborations with their experts. A two-hour lecture MS in Sustainable Development students was also done which included a presentation of VSU Scholarship program for international students.

The project was conceptualized in 2019 at Ghent University during the Aseanplus Global Platform Fellow attended by the dean. It was only in 2021 when the team was able to submit a project proposal for funding to the project collaborators in Belgium.

Thirteen Graduate Degree Programs Pass AACCUP Accreditation

hirteen graduate degree programs of the Office of the Graduate School (ODGS) passed the AACCUP level IV accreditation held on May 24-26, 2022. These include the Master of Science in Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Education, Agricultural Extension, Agronomy, Animal Science, Development Communication, Entomology, Horticulture, as well as Ph. D degrees in Plant Pathology, Plant Protection, and Soil Science. The MS in Plant Pathology passed the evaluation without mandatory requirements, while the other 12 programs passed but need to comply with some mandatory requirements.

suitable condition for farming, her research on alternative crops has assisted the farmers in Eastern Visayas achieve higher income. She has led many pioneering biochemical and micronutrient studies on root and tuber crops. These crops are considered marginal commodities in the country but have great potential in ensuring food security, especially in remote areas. She has facilitated in providing scholarships to graduate with Latin Honors, GTAs, as well as foreign graduate students and has recommended our graduate students in getting scholarships abroad.

In 2013, Dr. Tulin was also awarded with the Distinguished Alumnus Award in Research and Extension by the College of Agriculture Alumni Association, and in 2018, the Outstanding Alumnus Award of the University of the Philippines Los Baños.


